Located from NW 10th Ave.- NW 12th Ave./NW 54th St.
Secure parking for volunteers and parade staff will be in the Winn-Dixie Parking Lot: 1150 NW 54th St.
Perimeter access zones will be set up to reach staging and parking areas.
There is plenty of available parking for support staff centrally aligned with the Parade Route.

PARADE AND FESTIVAL PARKING

To promote public transportation and provide safe and easily accessible parking, Metro-Dade Transit Authority will provide free parking for Parade and Festival attendees at all of their designated Metro-Rail Stations. Once parked, you may ride the train free of charge to the Parade and Family-Fun Festival.

Shuttle buses will transport commuters from the festival back to the Brownsville Station.

Secure parking for Volunteers will be at Partners Park, 5336 NW 21st Ave. and Olinda Park, 2101 NW 54th St.

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PARADE GUIDELINES AND POLICIES

Participants must refrain from explicit demonstrations that do not reflect Dr. King's message and legacy

Parade assignments, unloading and loading points for transported participants and the Parade's disbanding points are diagramed on Parade Route Map (attached). Parade assignments will NOT be changed, except upon late arrival. (See attachment #1)

All floats must be completed before entering the staging area. Incomplete floats will not be allowed to enter the Parade.

The staging area is the location where all Parade units are physically assigned their positions in the Parade. Parade Marshals and/or Assistants will indicate your assigned division location. To avoid added congestion in the Parade's staging area, only Parade participants should be allowed to enter this area.

All parade units must be in their assigned position no later than 9:00 a.m. Those not in position will be left out of the parade line-up or reassigned to a rear position. It is recommended that all participants do whatever is necessary to be comfortable prior to entering the staging area.

ALL UNITS MUST BE ATTRACTIVELY DECORATED, UNIFORMED AND IDENTIFIED.

Riders on each float must be safely secured. Only assigned float riders from the sponsoring organization are allowed to be on board.

NO items of any type may be thrown from any unit, at any time before or during the parade.

The person(s) in charge of Parade unit(s) is/are expected to physically remain with and monitor the group from the beginning to the end of the Parade.

Marching units will continue without delay to move forward during the line of march. All bands will play while passing the reviewing stand. Please follow the directions of the Parade Marshals.

Participants must cooperate with Parade Marshals, Police, etc., to maintain a continuous, open line of procession.

Participants and/or units unable to complete the Parade route must be completely cleared from the procession of the Parade.

To avoid added congestion in the disbanding area, participants should promptly clear out in an orderly fashion to make room for following units following to disband.

THE DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. PARADE & FESTIVITIES COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO EXCLUDE ANY UNIT NOT MEETING COMMITTEE STANDARDS.

Neither the Dr. Martin L. King, Jr. Parade & Festivities Committee, the Liberty City Festival of the Arts Committee, nor its institutional affiliates shall be held responsible for any acts of theft, injury, or any other misfortune that may occur or befall any participant or spectator before, during, or after the parade and ensuing festival event.

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
